Stockton, Ill., Nov. 14.—Dr. Melvin H. Gouse, who practiced dentistry here for many years, died Saturday noon in a hospital at Coral Gables, Fla. He and his family had moved to West Palm Beach, Fla., last February for his health.

A native of Derinda township, he was married Oct. 10, 1937, to Mildred Tucker. He was instrumental in founding the Memorial park at Stockton, was past president of the Stockton Lions club, a member of the American Legion, and belonged to the Masonic and Eastern Star lodges.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday in Miami, Fla.
