STOCKTON—John Peter Haas, 61, died Monday evening at his farm home three miles southwest of Warren following a long illness

Mr. Haas was born July 30, 1892, in Wuerttemberg, Germany, a son of Christoph and Barbara (Sehrle) Haas. He was married to Ella Wurster on Dec. 19, 1923, who survives.

Other survivors are four daughters, Evelyn and Emma of Rockford and Freda and Martha at home; two sons, Richard at home and Frederick of Ft. Sheridan and one sister. A brother and a sister died previously.

Mr. Haas was a veteran of World War I and a former member of the Stockton American Legion.

Funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Hermann Funeral Home, Stockton, with a Warren minister officiating. Burial will be in Woodbine Cemetery. The American Legion will conduct a military graveside service.
