William G. Hubb

ELIZABETH — Funeral service was held this afternoon in St. Paul's Lutheran Church for William G. Hubb. Burial was in Elizabeth Cemetery.

Hubb, a lifelong resident of Elizabeth, died Friday afternoon at his farm home in Woodbine Township. The son of George and Minnie Hubb, he was born Feb. 15, 1896, in the Woodbine area. He operated the same farm here since his marriage to Lilly Atz in Kansas City, Mo., Dec. 7, 1924.

A World War I veteran, he served 21 months overseas. He was a member of the Stockton American Legion Post and St. Paul's Church and was vice president of Woodbine Mutual Insurance Co. for 31 years.

Surviving are his wife; one son, William Hubb Jr.; one granddaughter; four sisters, Mrs. Bertha Hartwig, Freeport, Mrs. Lottie Stiefel, Stockton, Miss Katherine Hubb, Woodbine, Mrs. Fred Fahrion, Vandalia, Mo., and one brother, Charles, Savanna.
