STOCKTON — Felix E. Julius of Stockton died Wednesday night in Freeport Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

Mr. Julius, a World War I veteran, operated furniture stores in Stockton and Freeport. He was a member of Freeport Veteran of Foreign Wars.

Born Aug. 9, 1891, in Chicago, he was the son of Edward E. and Helena (Marks) Julius. He attended Bayless Business College in Dubuque, Iowa. On Aug. 18, 1954, he married Anna Wolff in Germany.

Surviving are his widow; and a sister, Mrs. George (Mary) Schuckert of Stockton. A brother preceded him in death.

Funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Saturday in Hermann Funeral Home here. Cremation will follow.

There will be no visitation.
