

**Obituary for W. Kalzcnbcrtcr****Corp. D. W. Katzenberger**

Pearl City, Ill., Jan. 20.—Funeral services for Corporal Donald W. Katzenberger, who was killed Saturday night when his parachute failed to open after he jumped from a bomber which fell in flames near Tenaha, Texas, will be held Thursday afternoon at 1 o'clock at the Offenheiser funeral home and later at the Eben Ezer church, of which he was a member, Rev. Max Schroedel officiating.

Interment will be made in the adjoining cemetery, where a military service will be held.

Corporal Donald W. Katzenberger was the son of Christian Katzenberger and was born June 12, 1920, in Mt. Carroll. He made his home with his uncle, William Katzenberger, in Loran. Surviving are his father; a sister, Dorothy, and two brothers, Harold and Royal Katzenberger, of Pearl City.

He enlisted Oct. 22, 1941, and was an aerial engineer at Barksdale Field, Texas.
