STOCKTON — Edward F. Klopf of Stockton died Saturday noon following an extended illness.

He had farmed near Stockton. He was a World War I veteran and a member of the American Legion at Stockton.

He was born Sept. 6, 1889, in Derinda Township, the son of Henry and Margaret (Albright) Klopf. He married Myrtle Wofford June 24, 1933, in Galena.
