STOCKTON—Funeral service for Fred J. Kopf of rural Stockton, who died Sunday morning in Freeport Memorial Hospital after an extended illness, was held this afternoon in St. John Lutheran Church at Massbach.

Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Klopf, a farmer, was a member of St. John Church.

Born June 4, 1896, in Woodbine Township, Jo Daviess County, he was the son of Joseph and Margaret (Guentzler) Klopf. He married Cora Eden Jan. 26, 1921, in rural Stockton.
