Services Set For Vietnam Casualty

STOCKTON — Funeral service for Lance Cpl. Michael D. Kuhse, formerly of the Stockton and Savanna areas, who was killed May 17 in Vietnam, will be Monday at 2 p.m. in Zion Lutheran Church in Schapville. Burial will be with full military rites in the church cemetery.

Friends may call from 7 to 9 p.m. Saturday and after noon Sunday at Hermann Funeral Home in Stockton.

Kuhse was born Aug. 5, 1946, in Sterling, the son of Merrill and Mary (Trude) Kuhse. His father died in February.

Kuhse attended Savanna schools and graduated from high school in Huntsville, Ala.

He enlisted in the Marines in October 1964, receiving his basic training at Camp Lejeune, N.C. He served aboard the aircraft carriers Lake Champlain and Forrestal. He was personal escort for astronaut Gordon Cooper while on the Gemini 5 recovery mission.

In addition to his mother, Kuhse is survived by a sister, Mrs. Rita Seagroves of Huntsville.
