STOCKTON—Mrs. John Lyons of Stockton, World War I veteran, serving as an Army nurse at Camp Grant, died Wednesday at 1 p.m. of an apparent heart attack in a Freeport hospital where she had been a patient 15 hours.

She was a member of Stockton Methodist Church and had lived in the Stockton area all her life.

The former Florence Bryson was born Aug. 26, 1887, in Woodbine Township, Jo Daviess County, daughter of Frank and Mary (McKenzie) Bryson. On March 1, 1939, she married John Lyons in Dubuque, Iowa.

Survivors include her husband and a brother, Donald of Kent. She was preceded in death by one sister.

Funeral service will be Friday at 2 p.m. in Stockton Methodist Church with Rev. D. James Fitzhugh, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in Elizabeth Cemetery.
