Stockton, Ill., Sept. 1.—Jacob Nadig, 93, a Civil war veteran and a highly esteemed resident of Rush township for many years, died at the home of his son Ernest late Thursday afternoon, his death being attributed mainly to the infirmities of his advanced age. His wife, who was Theresa Shultz, passed away some years ago and after her death he lived alone until failing health necessitated his moving to the home of his son. His immediate survivors are three sons and one daughter, William, Ernest, Henry and Miss Loetta, all residents of the vicinity of Stockton. There is also one grandson and two great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at the home of his son, Ernest, at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon.

There will be Masonic rites, also a military service, conducted by the American Legion. Burial will be in the Townsend cemetery.
