

## Obituary for Henry Page

### Henry Page

STOCKTON — Henry Page of Stockton died at his home Monday of an apparent heart attack.

He was born Oct. 8, 1895, in New Bloomfield, Pa., son of Zachariah and Mahala (Orwan) Page. He came to Stockton with his parents at the age of 14. He married Ora Shutters April 1, 1921, in Stockton, where they lived their entire married life.

Mr. Page a locomotive carpenter for the Chicago Great Western Railroad for 27 years, was later employed by Kraft Foods here until his retirement. He was a World War I veteran and a member of the Stockton American Legion Post.

Surviving are his widow; one son, James of Stockton, four grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and one sister, Mrs. Alice Dickman of West Union, Iowa. Seven brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Hermann Funeral Home, Stockton. The Rev. Harold Patterson, assisted by the Rev. Charles Fleck, will officiate. Burial will be in Ladies Union Cemetery here.
