

WILLIAM D. REUSCH

William D. Reusch of Derinda township died in France, August 31, 1918. He entered the service May 25, 1918, at Camp Gordon, Atlanta, Ga. He was a private in the 47th Infantry. Pvt. Reusch left Camp Merritt for overseas service July 22, 1918, and landed at Liverpool, England. From there he went to France, and on his way to the front contracted measles which developed into pneumonia. Pvt. Reusch up to the time he entered the U. S. Army service, made his home with his parents on their farm in Derinda township.
