

**Obituary for Thomas H. Hchap (Aged 55)****Thomas Schap**

Stockton, Ill., June 30.—Thomas H. Schap, 55, died Sunday afternoon in a Freeport hospital. He was born in Stockton Jan. 6, 1892, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Henry Schap and had resided here his entire lifetime. He was a veteran of World War I, and had conducted a blacksmith shop.
