Carl Ralph Stewart of Stockton was killed in action at Chateau Thierry on July 27, 1918, while maintaining telephone connections. Stewart was the first fatality from Stockton. Carl Stewart entered the service from Stockton, Sept. 6, 1917, was sent to Camp Grant, and made a member of the Signal Signal Corps. He sailed for France March 9, 1918. Mr. Stewart was 26 years of age at death. Mr. Stewart was very well known in Stockton, and the surrounding community. His picture does not belie his good nature, for he was a friend to all his acquaintances.
