MT. CARROLL—Services for Cpl. Donald Streicher, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Streicher of Massbach, who was killed May 13 in Korea, will be Sunday at 1:30 p.m. in the Christian Funeral Home, Mt. Carroll, and at 2 in the First Lutheran Church.

Rev. E. A. Kreppert, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery. The American Legion will conduct military rites at the grave.

Cpl. Streicher entered the Army about a year before he was killed. He had been serving with the 44th National Guard Division in Korea.

Surviving besides his parents are three brothers, Wayne of Massbach, Glenn at home, Delmar of Ft. Wayne, Ind.; and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Joe Zink of Mt. Carroll.
