STOCKTON—Mrs. Louie Thomas, 45, of Detroit, formerly of Stockton, died early Monday in a Detroit hospital.

The former Rachel Lingford was born in Stockton Jan. 22, 1910, the daughter of Lawrence and Theresa McCarthy Lingford. On May 19, 1934, she was married to Louie Thomas and moved to Detroit. She was an Army nurse during World War II.

Surviving are her husband; one sister, Mrs. Samuel (Ruth) Patterson of South Pasadena, Calif.; her stepmother, Mrs. Louie Lingford; and a half-sister, Miss Margaret Lingford, both of Stockton.

Funeral service will be Friday at 9:30 a.m. (CST) in Holy Cross Catholic Church. The Rev. Alfred Dietsch, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in the church cemetery. The Rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. today in the Hermann Funeral Home.
