

## GEORGE P. WILLIAMS

Geo. P. Williams died Sept. 12, 1918, of wounds received in action that day on one of the American battle fronts in France. George P. Williams was 27 years of age at the date of his untimely death. He bid near and dear ones a last fond adieu when he left home for Camp Gordon, Ga., May 24th, 1918. Here he was assigned to Co. K., 28th U. S. Infantry and on July 21st he sailed from Hoboken, N. J. for military service in France. He was a brother of Frank Williams of Stockton, formerly of Galena. Mr. Williams was a man of good character who made and kept his friends, and it was a great shock to them on hearing of his death.
