

Arthur H. Albrecht

Arthur H. Albrecht, 77, of Elizabeth, died Aug. 11, 1992, at Mercy Hospital in Dubuque.

He was born Sept. 1, 1914, in Massbach, the son of Jacob and Emma Reusch Albrecht.

He married Pauline Knauer on May 2, 1943, in Elizabeth.

He became a partner in Albrecht Brothers John Deere farm equipment in Elizabeth in 1945. In 1959 he established the Albrecht Steel Structure business. In 1978 he formed A&B Steel, Inc., of which he was president until the company was dissolved in 1992.

He was a World War II veteran, having served in the Pacific Theater.

He was a member of Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church, the Elizabeth Lions Club, the Small Businessmen's Association, the Jo Daviess County Taxpayers' Association and the Golden Agers.

He was a past member of the church council and the ushers' club at Faith Lutheran Church, and a past member of the Elizabeth school board.

He was an avid baseball fan and gardener.

Survivors include his wife, Pauline, of Elizabeth; three daughters, Mrs. John (Susan) Fiesler of Elizabeth, Mrs. Terry (Sonja) Bauer of Elizabeth, Mrs. Scott (Kathleen) Hendee of Rockton; one son, Markof Armada, Mich.; two brothers, Glen of Elizabeth, Lester of Massbach; and ten grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother.

Services were held Aug. 14, 1992, at Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church, with burial in Woodbine Cemetery in Woodbine. The Rev. Kenneth Arndt of Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church officiated.

Military honors were accorded by the Hanover VFW.
