

## DIES IN VETERANS' HOSPITAL AT IOWA CITY

Delmar Wallace Aurand, 62, passed away at 6:30 o'clock Wednesday evening, September 18 at the Veterans hospital in Iowa City where he had been a patient for seven weeks.

He was the son of Thomas and Phillinda Sprague Aurand, and was born in Sabula, Iowa on Feb. 2, 1895.

On Nov. 18, 1920 he was married to Alice Baysinger who survives. He also leaves his aged mother, five daughters and one son: Mrs. Raymond (Lois) Dascher of Warren; Mrs. Vernon (Kathryn) Deihl, Elizabeth; Mrs. Leroy (Delores) Leibert, Delma Jean and Carol, all of Stockton, and Paul of Kankakee. There are four sisters and six brothers: Mrs. Elsie Blish, DeKalb; Mrs. William (Berniece) Boelk, Freeport; Lillian Aurand, Stockton; Mrs. Leo (Bessie) Wetzel, Warren; Edward Aurand, Arkdale, Wis.; George, Detroit; Harry, DeKalb; Arthur, Loves Park; Glen, Minnesota; and Leland of Stockton. His father, one daughter, one son, one sister and one brother died previously.

Delmar was a member of the Church of the Nazarene and a veteran of World War I. He had farmed in this locality all of his married life and was well known.

The funeral was held at 2:00 o'clock Saturday at the Hermann funeral home. Rev. R. E. Bauerle, pastor of the Church of the Nazarene officiated, and burial was in the Louisa cemetery, northeast of Stockton.
