STOCKTON — George H. Callan died Sunday in Veterans' Administration Hospital, Madison, where he had been a patient 17 days.

He was born Aug. 27, 1887, in Stockton, son of Edward and Elizabeth (Buckley) Callan and was married to Clara Palmer On July 25, 1933, in Dubuque, Iowa. He had farmed in this area all his life and was a veteran or World War I.

Surviving are his widow and a sister, Mrs. Julia O'Brien of Dubuque.

Service will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday in Holy Cross Catholic Church here with Rev. Clarence J. Thennes, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in St. Patrick's Cemetery, in Pleasant Valley Township, South of Stockton.
