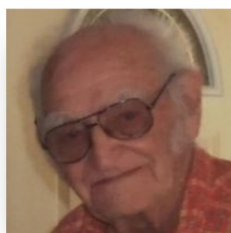

Edward "Eddie" Wixson Coppernoll 1921–2017

Edward "Eddie" Wixson Coppernoll, 95, of Stockton, IL, passed away Tuesday, April 11, 2017, at FHN Memorial Hospital in Freeport.
