SAVANNA — Services for Frank Creighton, Savanna, who died Monday in a local hospital where he had been a patient eight days, were held at 10 this morning in St. John's Catholic Church. Burial was in Holy Cross Cemetery, Stockton.

Mr. Creighton was born Oct. 8, 1886, at Pleasant Valley, south of Stockton, to George and Ellen (Shea) Creighton. He never married.

He was a retired warehouse manager for Interstate Power Co. here, a veteran of World War I and a member of the American Legion and St. John's Church.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Maude Kunkel, Byron, and Mrs. Agnes Kepner, Rockford, and a brother, George Creighton, Montreal, Canada.
