STOCKTON - Funeral service for Joseph H. Daves of Stockton was held today in Hermann Funeral Home. The Rev. Charles Fleck of Calvary United Methodist Church officiated and burial was in Woodbine Cemetery.

Mr. Daves, a retired farmer and World War I veteran, died Friday evening in Freeport Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

He was born in Woodbine Township, Jo Daviess County, March 31, 1892, son of George L. and Barbara (Hess) Daves. He married Ida Mae Penticoff May 19, 1923, in Hazel Green, Wis. She died in August 1950.

Surviving are three sons, Charles and Lyle of Stockton and George of Moline; a daughter, Miss Marian Daves of Lena; two sisters, Mrs. Thomas (Grace) Reed of Freeport and Mrs. Herman (Clara) Dascher of Stockton; and 11 grandchildren. He was also preceded in death by a son, two brothers and three sisters.
