STOCKTON — Funeral service for Fern C. Davis of Elizabeth, formerly of Pleasant Valley, will be at 2 p.m. Monday in Hermann Funeral Home, here. The Rev. Richard A. Wang, pastor of Elizabeth United Methodist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in Ladies Union Cemetery.

He died Thursday night in the Veterans Administration Hospital at Madison, Wis., following a brief illness.

Mr. Davis, a member of Lena American Legion and Carroll County Barracks, Veterans of World War I, farmed in the Stockton area until retiring.

Born March 17, 1887, in Wards Grove Township, Jo Daviess County, he was the son of William J. and Emma Rebecca (Nuss) Davis. On Oct. 13, 1925, he married Leola Graves near Stockton.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Ralph (Corinne) Timmons of Rockford and Mrs. Vernon (Thelma) Law of Savanna; a son, Coleman of Freeport; and a brother, Snell of Clarendon Hills. He was preceded in death by his wife, two sisters and two brothers.
