GRATIOT, Wis. — John A Doyle of Gratiot, Wis., died Saturday night in a Darlington, Wis., nursing home where he had been a patient for the past 10 days.

Mr. Doyle, a lifelong Gratiot area resident and World War I veteran, was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church and the American Legion in Gratiot.

He was born Nov. 11, 1891, in Gratiot, son of William and Elizabeth (McGinnis) Doyle. He married May Reichel May 21, 1922, in Chicago. She died Dec. 20, 1969.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Pearl Zeigle of Rockford and Mrs. C. J. Kerwan of Detroit, Mich.

Funeral service will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday in St. Joseph's Catholic Church. The Rev. Raymond Haas, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
