

Welcome to the Stockton Heritage Museum's Website Veterans Memorial Directory Page.

This page was developed to allow access to our documentation of the Veterans on the Stockton Veterans Memorial.

Check out the tips shown below to learn the many ways to navigate and sort information in the directory. The database contains over 1,700 names and will take awhile to load (load times vary according to internet speed and device).

TIPS FOR NAVIGATING THE STOCKTON VETERANS MEMORIAL DIRECTORY

- 1 The directory is designed so that you can choose to view 20, 50, 100 or all of the records at one time. Click this field to show a drop down box with an option to **change the number of names shown per page**.
- 2 If you choose to view all records, clicking this **gray up arrow** will take you back to the top of the page and the start of the file.
- 3 The **search command** offers great flexibility for finding information. Enter a key work in **Search** box and hit return; the computer will search the data field and display all matching entries. Typical search keywords, shown in (ex: parenthesis) could include:
 - Surname (ex: Evans)
 - Branch of service (ex: Army)
 - Era (ex: Korea)
 - Deceased (ex: Yes)
 - Burial location (ex: Ladies Union)
 - Stockton schools (ex: 1974)Please note for the two World Wars we are using WW1 and WW2.
- 4 If you want a new search, click the **Reset** button to return all columns to the initial page layout.
- 5 You may sort on any of the fields by ascending or descending order by clicking on the **gray arrows** (▲ or ▼) to the right of the column headers..
- 6 We are working to put together **Biographies** for all veterans. Clicking on the entry in the Bio column will open up a PDF file that includes the information that has been collected for that individual. Many of the WW1 veterans have bios developed with information from the World War 1 booklet published in 1993 (Listed as WW1). We plan to add new biographies to the database on a regular basis as they are created.
- 7 The **Grave** field is the link to the actual Find-a-Grave Link in the Find-a-Grave software program.
- 8 The **Obituary** field will open a PDF of a scanned obituary file. To drill down, use both keyword search and sort to find relevant information. Search for the keyword Obit to see all the files with attached obituaries, and then use the arrows to sort by name, date of birth, date of death, or any other fields.
- 9 **Status** – Indicates whether the veteran was Killed in Action (KIA), Died Non-Battle (DNB), and/or was a Prisoner of War (POW).
- 10 **Era** – Indicates the time frame of service.
- 11 **Branch** – Indicates Veteran's Branch of service.
- 12 **Years Served** – Indicates Veteran's length of service.
- 13 **Dec'd** – Indicates whether Veteran is deceased (Listed as Yes for deceased or left blank for still living).
- 14 **Birthdate** – Indicates Veteran's birthdate in Year-Month-Date format.
- 15 **Deathdate** – Indicates Veteran's deathdate in Year-Month-Date format.
- 16 **Wall Location** – Indicates the location of the Veteran's name of the Memorial Wall. See the Stockton Veterans Memorial Information Sheet PDF for additional tips on finding the name.
- 17 **Cemetery Buried** – Indicates burial location for deceased Veterans (if known).
- 18 **Division/Unit** – Indicates additional Veteran's service information (if known).
- 19 **Stockton School** – Indicates the year the Veteran graduated from Stockton High School (if applicable).
- 20 **Comments** – Additional Veteran information provided for database.
- 21 If you see a **plus sign** under the name in the left hand column, it means that all columns were not
